MEMORANDUM OPINION

This is an appeal from a judgment signed December 21, 2000. On May 10, 2001, this Court ordered the parties to mediation. On August 22, 2001, a mediator's report was filed stating the case had settled. Therefore, according to this Court's May 10, 2001 order, the parties had ten days to file a motion to dismiss or other dispositive motion. No motion was filed. On September 27, 2001, the Court ordered the parties to file a dispositive motion within ten days. Appellant requested and received an extension of time to file the motion until November 19, 2001. Again, no motion was filed. On December 20, 2001, the Court again ordered the parties to file a motion to dismiss within ten days. In that order, the Court

warned that failure to comply could result in dismissal or other sanctions. No motion was filed.

On January 7, 2002, notification was transmitted to all parties of the Court's intent to dismiss the appeal for failure to comply with this Court's orders. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3(c). Appellant filed no response.

Accordingly, the appeal is ordered dismissed.
