MEMORANDUM OPINION

This is an attempted accelerated appeal from an order signed May 22, 2000, which denied appellant's special appearance in a divorce action. Appellant's notice of appeal was filed August 15, 2001. The notice of appeal is untimely. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 26.1(b); 28.1. Moreover, this court has no jurisdiction over an interlocutory appeal of an order granting or denying a special appearance in suits brought under the Texas Family Code. *See* TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE ANN. § 51.014(a)(7) (Vernon Supp. 2001).

On September 26, 2001, notification was transmitted to all parties of the Court's intent to dismiss the appeal for want of jurisdiction. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3(a). Appellant's response fails to demonstrate that this Court has jurisdiction to entertain the appeal.

Accordingly, the appeal is ordered dismissed.
