Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in two appeals on Tuesday, January 10, 2012, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Catherine Stone, Justice Sandee Bryan Marion, and Justice Steven C. Hilbig.

The following cases will be presented:

Sheronda R. Malcolm v. The State of Texas – Sheronda R. Malcolm appeals her conviction of theft. Malcolm asserts the evidence is insufficient to support her conviction and the omission of the statutory definition of the term “deception” from the jury charge resulted in egregious error.

Ex parte Matthew E. Green - Appellant, the Department of Public Safety (DPS), appeals the trial court’s order expunging the records of appellee, Matthew Green, for his arrest for unlawful carrying of a weapon. On appeal, DPS contends Green was not entitled to expunction under article 55.01 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure because he received deferred adjudication probation for that offense. Further, DPS contends Green failed to establish by legally sufficient evidence that he had not received court-ordered community supervision, thereby failing to comply with the statutory requirements for expunction under the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.

The oral arguments will be held in the Fourth Court’s Courtroom, Caden-Reeves Justice Center, Third Floor, 300 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas.
