ORDER

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this day came to be considered Defendant Justin Fuller's Motion to Determine that Anthony Wayne White is a Vexatious Litigant. After considering the pleadings of the parties filed herein and the argument of counsel, the Court is of the opinion that the following order should issue:

It is hereby ORDERED that said Motion is GRANTED. Plaintiff is hereby DETERMINED TO BE A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT.

THEREFORE, Anthony Wayne White is ordered to furnish security in the amount of \$ 211. The amount must be furnished to the court by 11-2-99.

Should Anthony Wayne White fail to furnish such security within the time set by this Order, the above referenced and numbered cause is DISMISSED. Should the case be dismissed upon its merits, Anthony Wayne White shall pay Defendant's reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with this litigation, including costs and attorney's fees.

MOREOVER, the clerk of the court is Ordered to refuse the filing of any litigation presented by Anthony Wayne White unless he obtains an order from the local administrative judge permitting the filing.

FINALLY, it is HEREBY ORDERED that Anthony Wayne White is prohibited from filing, *in propria persona*, any new litigation in a court in this state. A copy of this Order shall be provided to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
