**ORDER ON DEFENDANT DALLAS COUNTY'S AND JIM FOSTER'S
MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF KAVIN RHODES A VEXATIOUS
LITIGANT, STAY THE PROCEEDINGS AND REQUEST FOR SECURITY**

After considering *Defendant Dallas County's And Jim Foster's Motion To Declare Plaintiff Kavin Rhodes A Vexatious Litigant, Stay The Proceedings And Request For Security*, the Court hereby **GRANTS** the motion and declares plaintiff Kavin Rhodes a vexatious litigant.

Plaintiff Kavin Rhodes is required to post \$2500⁰⁰ with the District Clerk as security per the section 11.055 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code within 30 days of this order. If security is not timely posted, this case shall be *dismissed* pursuant to section 11.056 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

Furthermore, the Court prohibits the Plaintiff Kavin Rhodes from filing any new lawsuits *in propria persona* in any court Texas until he receives permission from the local administrative judge pursuant to sections 11.101 and 11.102 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
