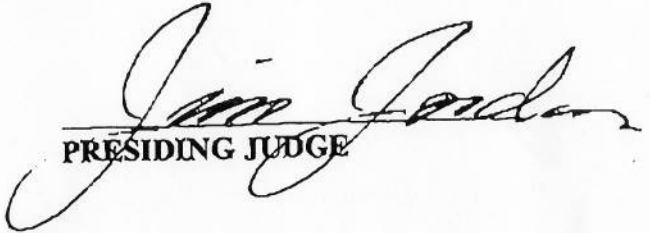
**ORDER ON MOTION FOR PREFILING ORDER PURSUANT
TO §11.101 OF THE TEXAS CIVIL PRACTICE & REMEDIES CODE**

A hearing was held on this date on the Motion of SAS Institute Inc., Phil Strand, and Jane Woyciehowsky ("Movants") for a Prefiling Order pursuant to §11.101 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code. The Court finds that, although the hearing on this Motion was properly noticed, Busch failed to appear.

At the hearing, the Court granted the Motion of Movants to Declare Busch a Vexatious Litigant pursuant to §11.054 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, thereby finding that Phil Busch was a vexatious litigant. The Court also heard the Movants' Motion for a Prefiling Order pursuant to §11.101 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, the exhibits, argument of Counsel, and evidence offered in support thereof and, after considering same, the Court hereby **GRANTS** the motion.

This Court prohibits Phil Busch from filing any new litigation *in propria persona* in any Texas court until Phil Busch receives permission from the local administrative judge pursuant to §11.101 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
