ORDER OF THE SUPREME COURT OF TEXAS

On May 23, 2003, after the State Commission on Judicial Conduct recommended that the Honorable Armando Garza, Municipal Court Judge, Edcouch, Hidalgo County, Texas, Respondent, be suspended without pay pursuant to Article 5, §1-a(6)A, Texas Constitution, and Rule 15(b) of the Procedural Rules for the Removal or Retirement of Judges, pending final disposition by the Commission of the charge against Respondent, the Supreme Court of Texas issued an order under Misc. Docket No. 03-9069, suspending Judge Garza from office without pay effective July 1, 2003, unless the judge presents to the Commission and the Court before that date evidence that he has completed the twelve (12) hours of education in which he was presently deficient.

Having considered the Commission's Withdrawal of Suspension Request, together with the evidence presented to the Commission that Judge Garza has completed the required hours of judicial education, it is the Order of the Supreme Court of Texas that the suspension of the Honorable Armando Garza, Municipal Court Judge, Edcouch, Hidalgo County, Texas, is hereby lifted or withdrawn.
