**ORDERED that:**



**OF THE 216<sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT COMPRISED OF**  
**KERR, KENDALL, GILLESPIE AND BANDERA COUNTIES**

- I. All cases filed in Kerr, Kendall, Gillespie and Bandera Counties involving Chapter 33 of the Texas Family Code, shall be filed with the District Clerk of said counties and docketed in the 216<sup>th</sup> District Court.
- II. The District Clerk will immediately notify the Court Administrator of the 216<sup>th</sup> District Court of a filing involving Chapter 33 of the Texas Family Code. All hearings required under Chapter 33 of the Texas Family Code, shall be conducted by the Judge of the 216<sup>th</sup> District Court, or a Judge sitting by Assignment in the 216<sup>th</sup> District Court.


