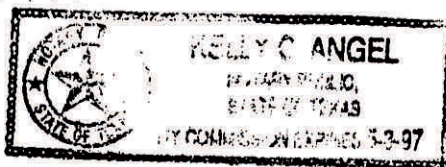
Enclosed is also the affidavit required by Section 6. I trust this will be sufficient to accomplish my voluntary resignation.

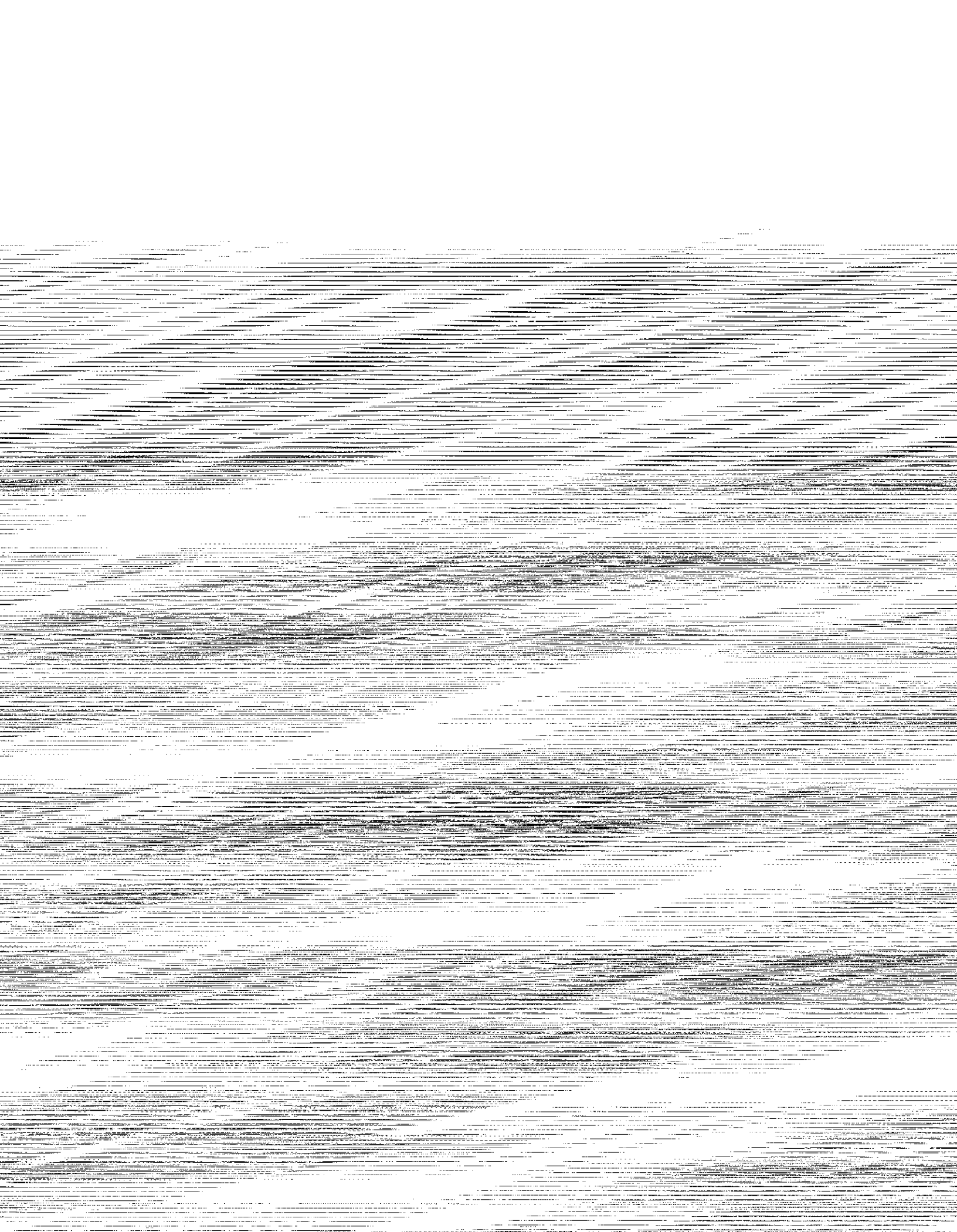

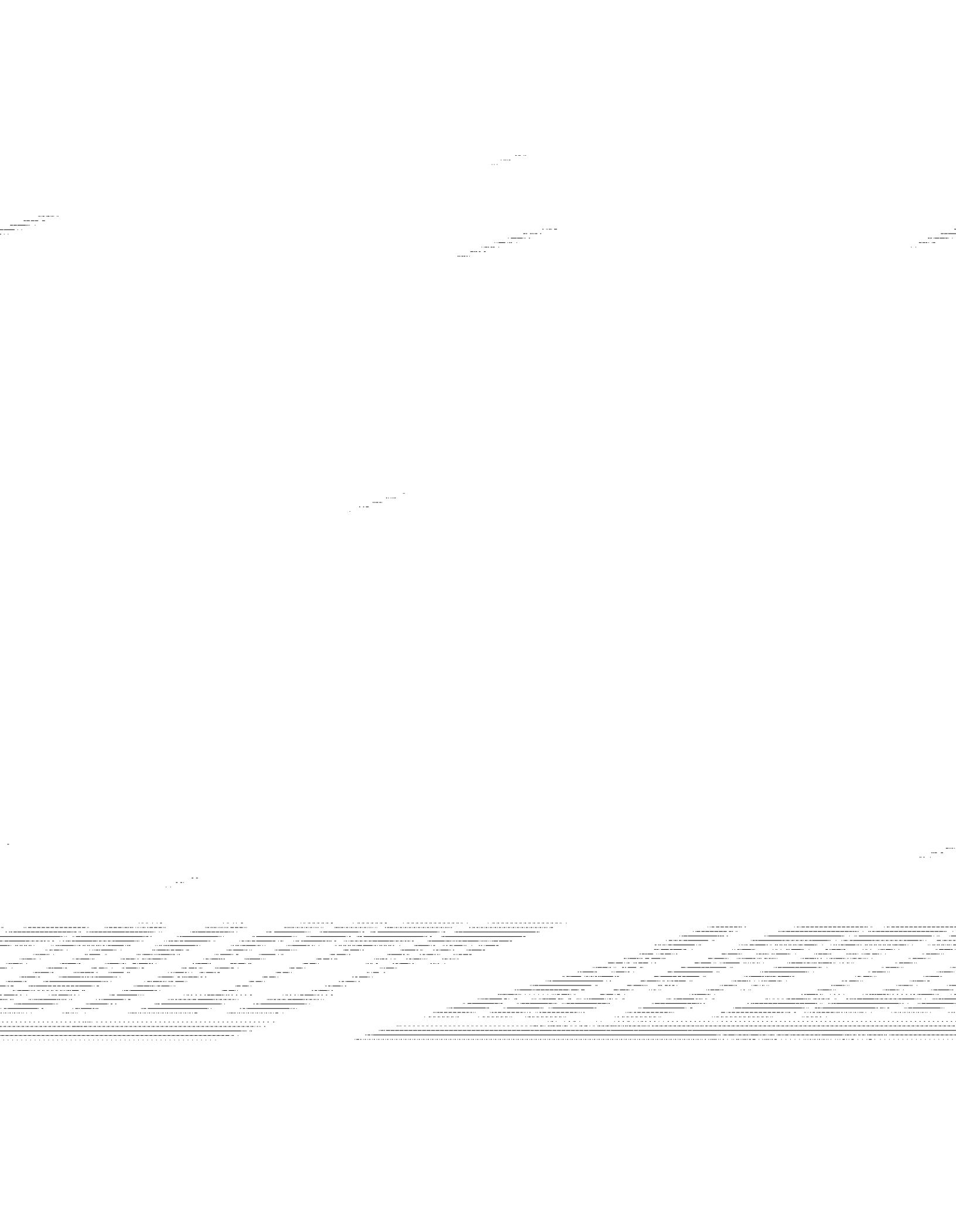

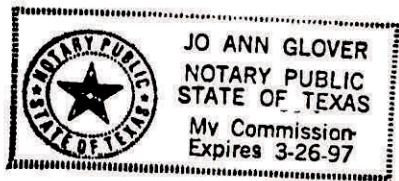
1. My name is Heather Joy Brown Markette and I currently live at [REDACTED]
