The Supreme Court of Texas hereby appoints the Honorable Burt Carnes, Judge of the 368th District Court, to preside in the Disciplinary Action styled:


The Commission for Lawyer Discipline v. Thomas J. Jackson


to be filed in a District Court of Harris County, Texas.


