


**ORDER OF THE COURT APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE 1995-1996
GENERAL FUND BUDGET OF THE STATE BAR OF TEXAS**


WHEREAS, the State Bar of Texas has, by petition filed with the clerk of this Court on September 21st, 1995, petitioned the Supreme Court of Texas to approve an amendment to its fiscal year 1995-1996 general fund budget of \$11,007.00 and to approve the action of the Board of Directors in adopting the amendment to the 1995-1996 general fund budget at its meeting on September 15, 1995 in Houston, Texas.

The State Bar of Texas respectfully hereby petitions the Court for budget amendment. In support hereof, the petitioner states as follows:


The Board of Directors of the State Bar of Texas, in its meeting on September 15, 1995, in Houston, Texas, at which meeting a quorum was present, moved and adopted, subject to the Court's approval, an amendment to the fiscal year 1995-1996 general fund budget as follows:

To increase the Office of the General Counsel budget by \$11,007. The increase to the fiscal year 1995-1996 budget is for the purpose of increasing a three quarter attorney position in the General Counsel's office to a full time position, as described in attached Exhibit A.


