The license and permanent State Bar card issued by this Court to the Applicant, Robert M. Rose as an Attorney and Counselor at Law are attached.

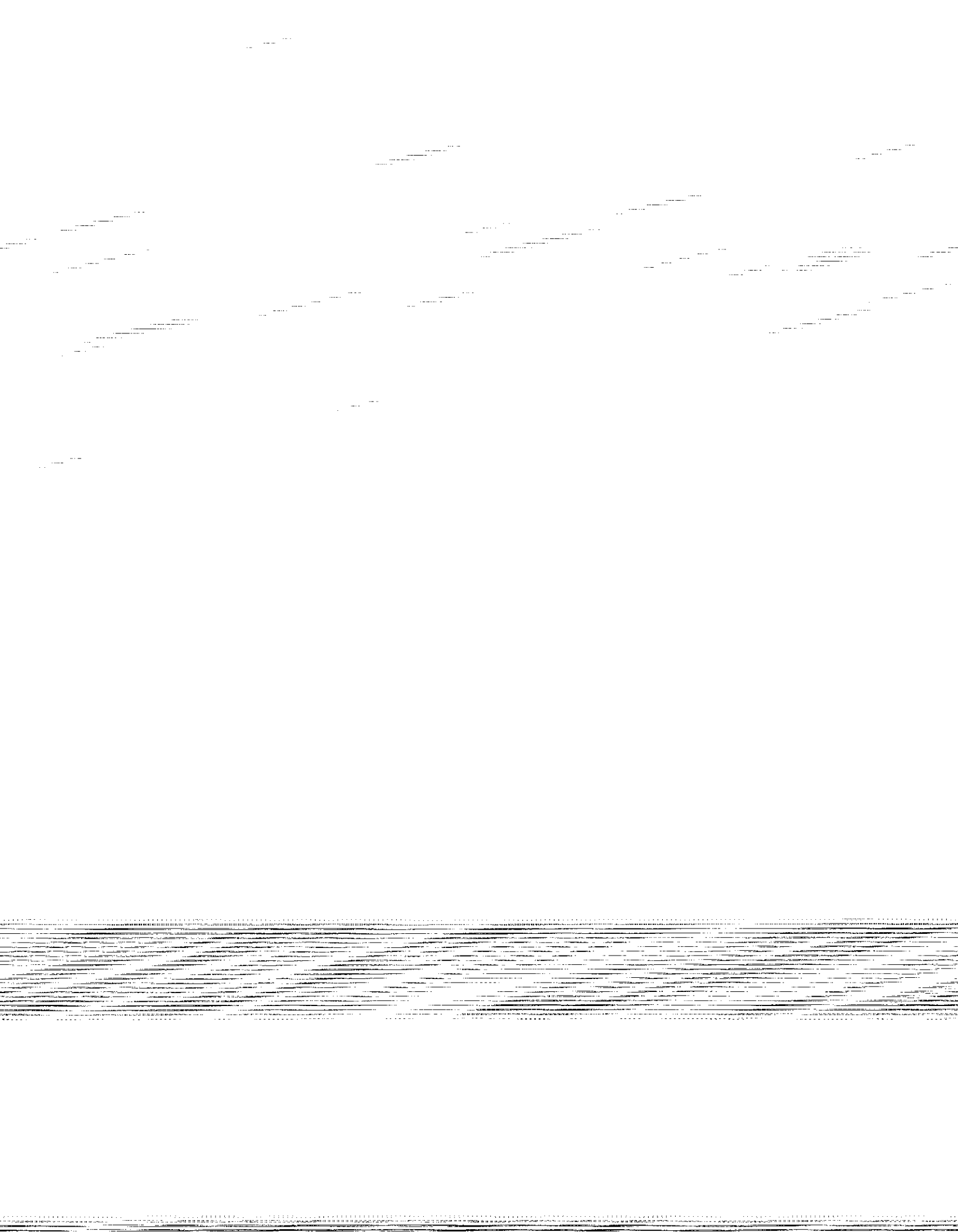

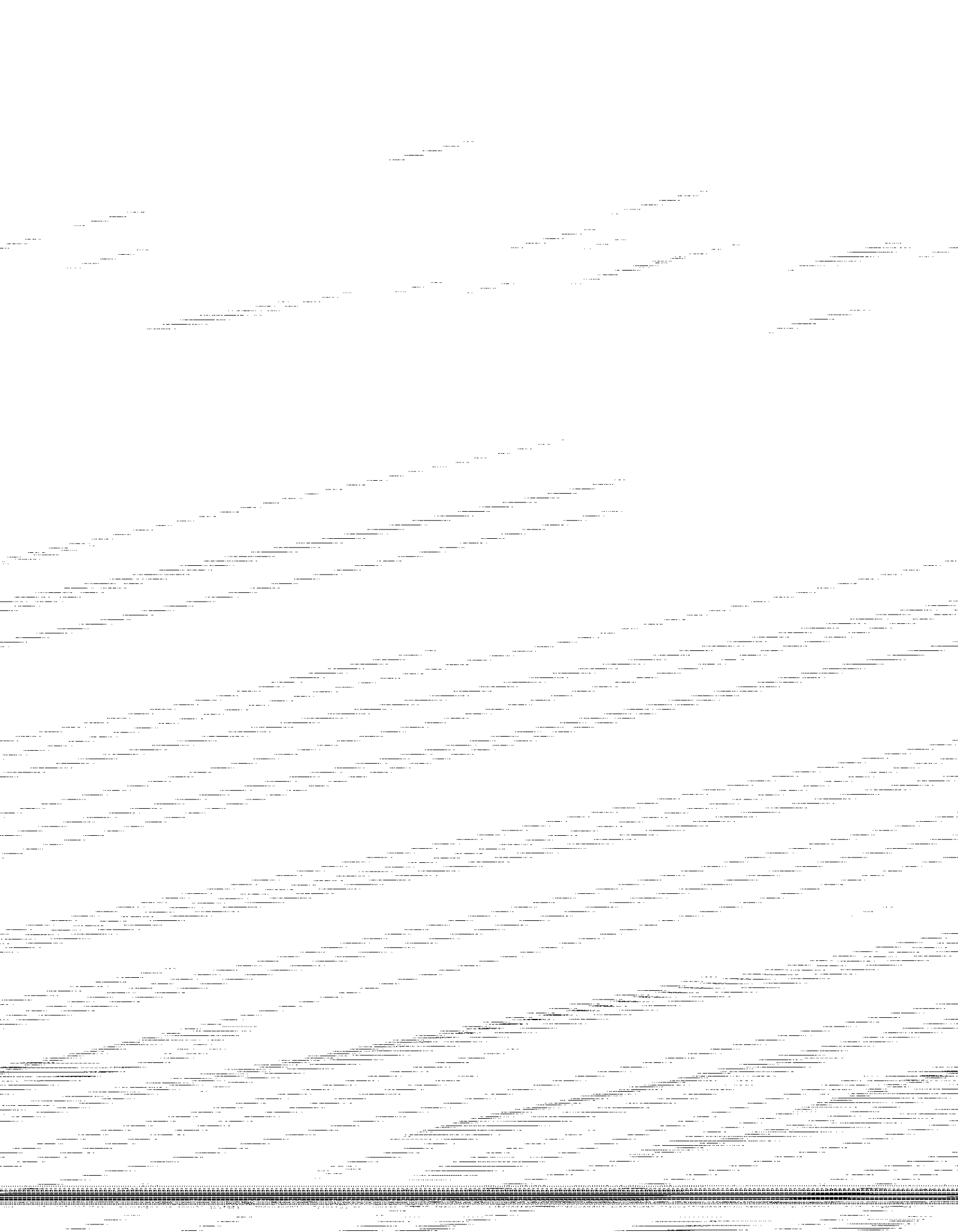

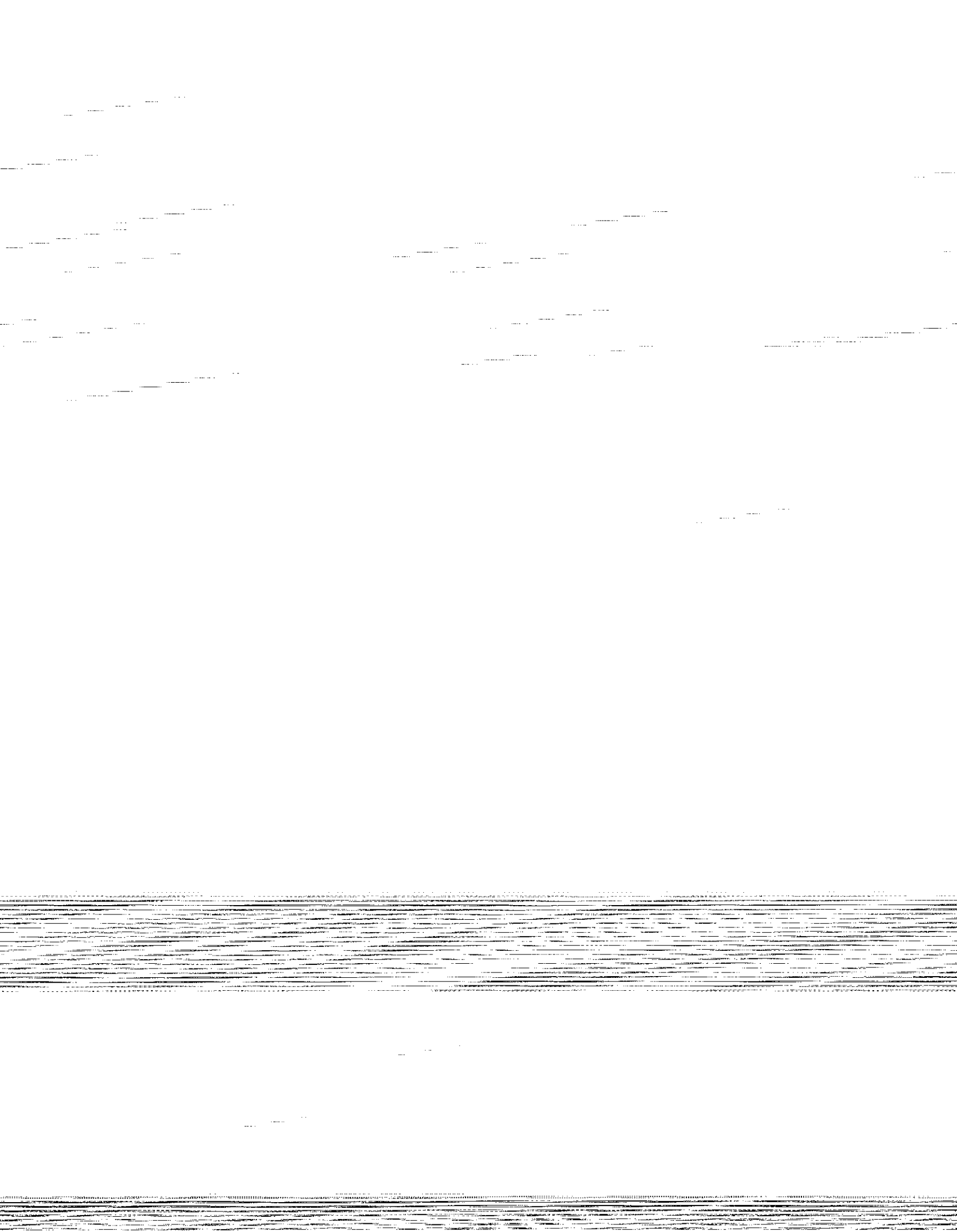
