TO THE HONORABLE SUPREME COURT OF TEXAS:

Movant, **Eugene Lamar Guyon, Jr.**, pursuant to Part X, Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure, moves the Court to accept his resignation as an attorney and counselor at law, showing the Court:

I.

Movant hereby resigns as an attorney and counselor at law in lieu of disciplinary sanction for having committed professional misconduct.

On or about October 15, 1994, Movant did intentionally and knowingly cause serious bodily injury to his grandmother, Lena Broyles, age 65 or older, by hitting Lena Broyles with a cane. Movant has been diagnosed as suffering from schizophrenia and is thereby mentally and/or emotionally disabled and not able to provide legal services necessary to protect the legal interests of any clients.
