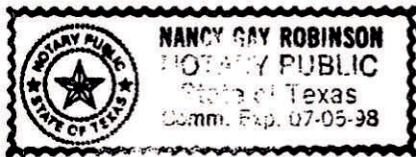
I, Jo Ann Berryhill, bar card #02252200, wish to voluntarily resign from the State Bar of Texas. This is my sworn affidavit stating:

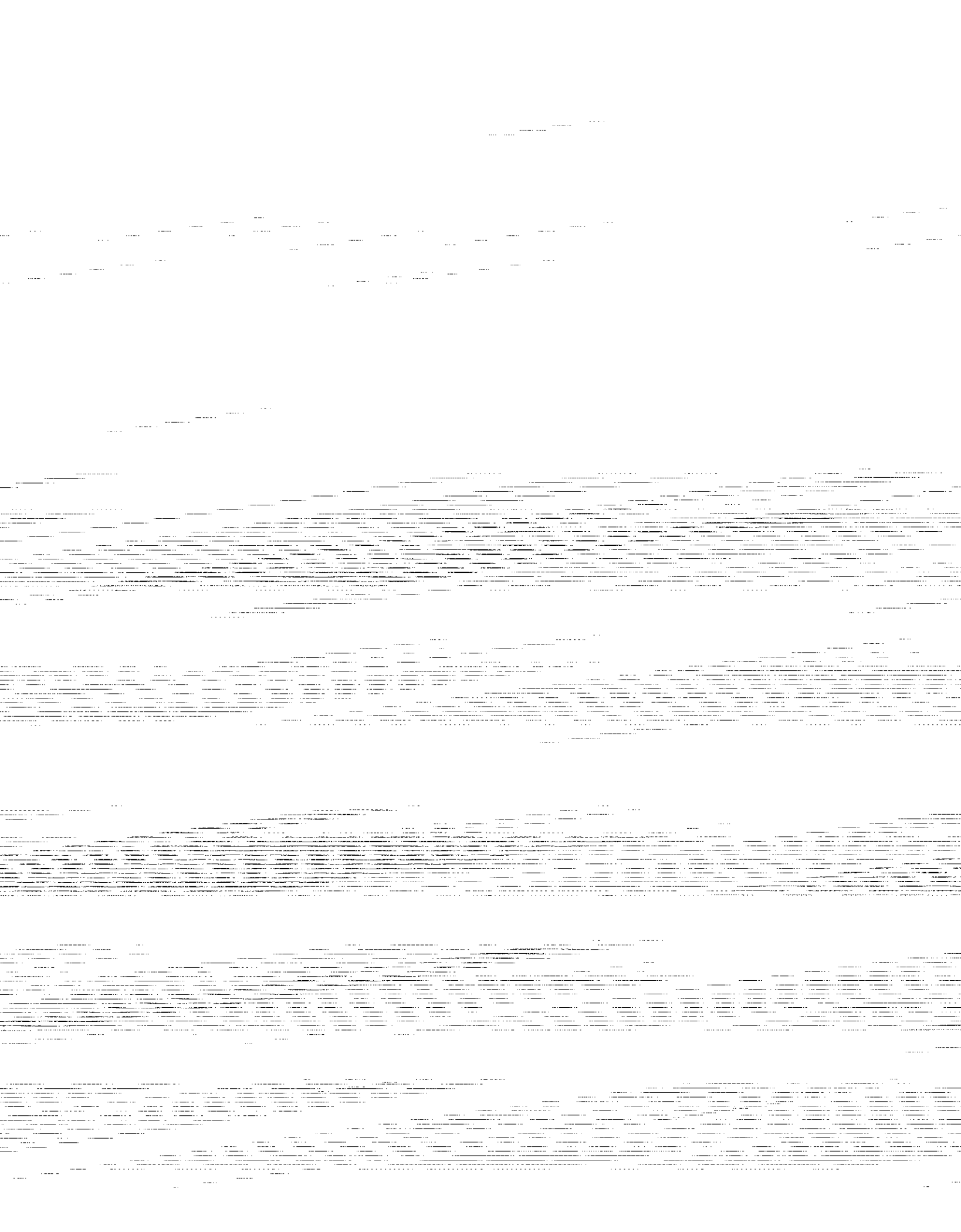


AUTHORIZATION AND RELEASE





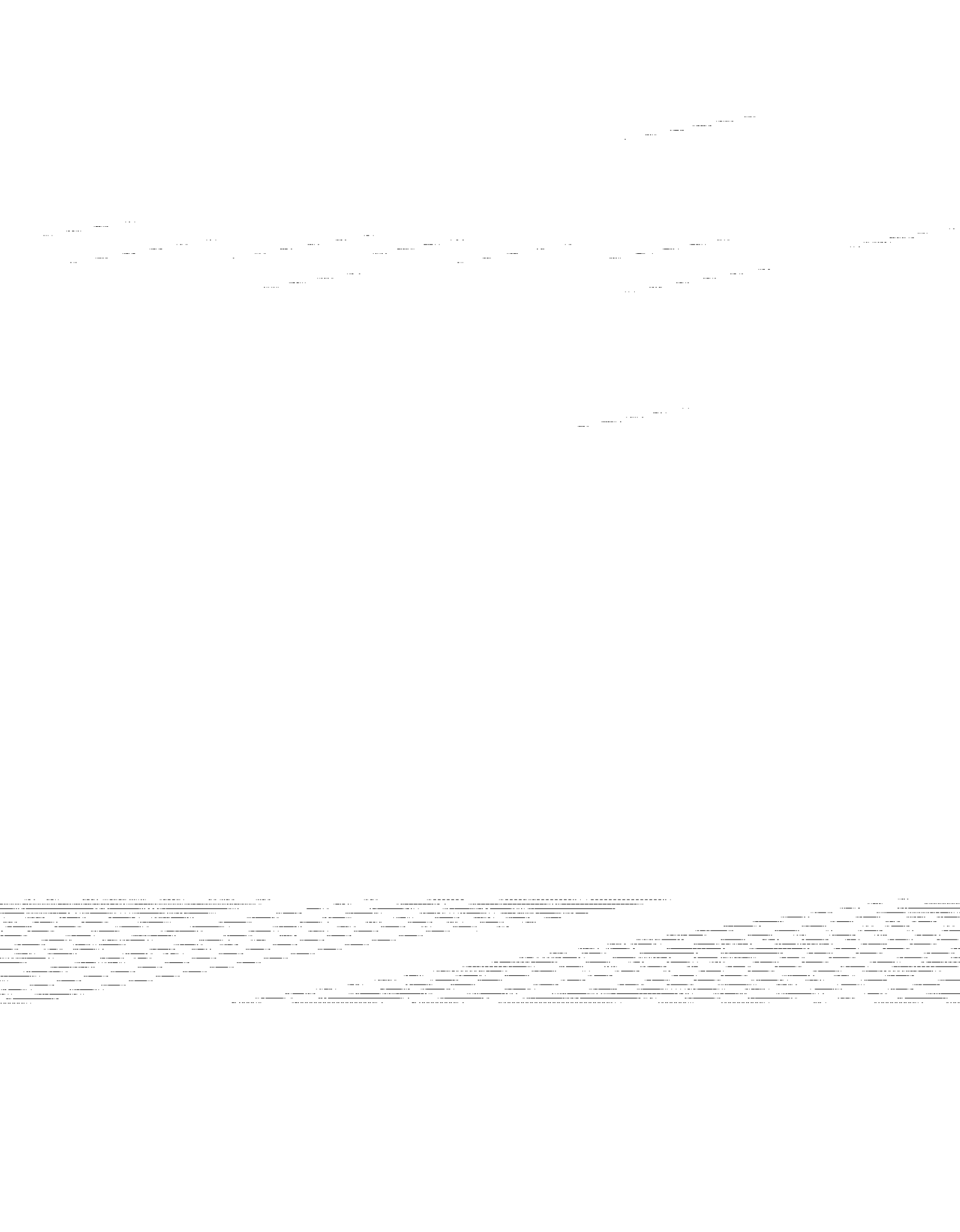
