## JUDGMENT IN A CRIMINAL CASE (For Offenses Committed On or After November 1, 1987)

The defendant, SAVAGE MARK LOVELL, was represented by David C. Schick.

On motion of the United States, the court has dismissed the remaining counts of the Indictment as to this defendant.

The defendant pleaded guilty to count(s) 1 of the Indictment filed on October 6, 1998. Accordingly, the defendant is adjudged guilty of such count(s), involving the following offense(s):
