

Counties That Redistricted Their Justice Courts

During fiscal year 2003, redistricting occurred in the justice of the peace precincts in Bee County as listed below. When the courts were assigned a *new* precinct number, activity data were compiled by judge and recorded under the judge's new precinct number in order to maintain consistency. For example, a judge may have served three months in the old precinct (Precinct 1-1) and nine months in the new precinct (Precinct 2-1). The judge's total reported activity equals the sum of the statistics for the periods served in the old precinct (Precinct 1-1) and the new precinct (2-1) and is reported under the new precinct (2-1) only.

The changes in precinct number resulting from redistricting are shown below.

Bee County:
