

Notes about Data for District Courts for FY 2012

At the time of publication, there was a 95.2 percent reporting rate overall for the fiscal year.

No reports were received from Castro, Dallam, Edwards, Gillespie, Hudspeth, Lamb, Maverick, Newton, Orange, and Zavala counties.

The following counties had incomplete reports:

- Brazos: Criminal reports missing for March through August 2012.
- Brewster: All reports missing for January through August 2012.
- Burleson: All reports missing for January through August 2012.
- Burnet: Civil and family reports missing for January through August 2012. Criminal reports missing for April through August 2012. Juvenile reports were missing for October 2011 through August 2012.
- El Paso: All juvenile reports were missing.
- Galveston: Criminal reports were missing from September 2011 through May 2012.
- Grayson: All juvenile reports were missing.
- Hidalgo: Civil reports were missing for May through August 2012. All juvenile reports were missing.
- Irion: All reports were missing for May through August 2012.
- Kendall: Criminal reports were missing for February through August 2012.
- Nueces: All juvenile reports were missing.
- Sabine: A juvenile report was missing for August 2012.
- San Saba: All reports were missing for August 2012.
- Starr: Civil, family and juvenile reports were missing for August 2012.
- Upton: Civil reports were missing for February through April 2012 and for August 2012. Family reports were missing for February through August 2012.
- Wilbarger: All reports were missing for November 2011 through August 2012.
