Members of the Jury:

The defendant, Jeffery Keith Prevost, stands charged by indictment with the offense of capital murder, alleged to have been committed on or about the 20th day of May, 2011, in Harris County, Texas. The defendant has entered a plea of guilty to the offense of capital murder as alleged in the indictment, to-wit:

In Harris County, Texas, Jeffery Keith Prevost, hereafter styled the Defendant, heretofore on or about the 20th day of May, 2011, did then and there unlawfully, during the same criminal transaction, intentionally and knowingly cause the death of Sherry White by shooting Sherry White with a deadly weapon, to-wit a firearm, and by stabbing Sherry White with a deadly weapon, to-wit a knife, and intentionally and knowingly cause the death of Kyle Lavergne by shooting Kyle Lavergne with a deadly weapon, to-wit a firearm.

Notwithstanding that, the Court, as required by law, has admonished him of the consequences. It plainly appearing to the Court that the Defendant is mentally competent, and that he makes this plea freely and voluntarily, said plea is received by the Court. You are instructed to find the Defendant guilty of the offense of capital murder, as charged in the indictment.

After you retire to the jury room, you should select one of your members as your Foreman. It is his or her duty to preside at your deliberations, vote with you, and when you have unanimously agreed upon a verdict, to certify to your verdict by using the appropriate form attached hereto and signing the same as Foreman.

You are the exclusive judges of the facts proved, of the credibility of the witnesses and of the weight to be given their testimony, but you are bound to receive the law from the Court, which has been given you.

No one has any authority to communicate with you except the officer who has you in charge. During your deliberations in this case, you must not consider, discuss, nor relate any matters not in evidence before you. You should not consider nor mention any personal knowledge or information you may have about any fact or person connected with this case which is not shown by the evidence.

Following the arguments of counsel, you will retire to deliberate your verdict.
