Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in two appeals on Tuesday, May 16, 2017, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Sandee Bryan Marion, Justice Rebeca C. Martinez, and Justice Irene Rios.

The following cases will be presented:

Peter Mark Lee v. The State of Texas – A jury found Peter Mark Lee guilty of the offense of assault with bodily injury, and the trial court assessed punishment at one year in jail, probated for two years. The issues on appeal are whether the trial court erred by (1) admitting statements made by the complainant during a 911 call in violation of Lee's Sixth Amendment right to confrontation; and (2) allowing an expert to give a lay opinion of how the complainant received her injuries.

Robert Carlos Del Cid v. The State of Texas - Appellant challenges his conviction for felony murder and resulting life sentence, arguing that he was denied the right to retained counsel of his choice and that he was denied the effective assistance of counsel at trial.

The oral arguments will be held in the Fourth Court's Courtroom, Cadena-Reeves Justice Center, Third Floor, 300 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas.
