ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS' MOTIONS TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT AND TO REQUIRE SECURITY

Before the Court are the following: (a) Defendants Rockline Industries, Inc., Randy Rudolph, and Alan Perlman's Motion To Declare Plaintiff A Vexatious Litigant Pursuant To Chapter 11, Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code; (b) Defendant David H. Timmins' Motion To Declare Plaintiff A Vexatious Litigant And To Require Security; (c) Defendants Gary D. Elliston, Pamela J. Williams, and Courtney G. Bowline's Motion for an Order Determining Plaintiff To Be A Vexatious Litigant And Requesting Security Pursuant To Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code Chapter 11; and (d) Defendants Continental Casualty Company, National Fire Insurance of Hartford, Dino E. Robusto, and Anthony Romas' Joinder In Rockline Industries' Motion To Declare Plaintiff A Vexatious Litigant. Having considered the motions, the evidence presented, and the arguments of counsel and any pro se parties, the Court is of the opinion that the motions should be granted.

It is therefore ORDERED that Defendants' motions to declare Plaintiff Stephen Matthew Avdeef a vexatious litigant are hereby GRANTED.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Stephen Matthew Avdeef is declared a vexatious litigant pursuant to Section 11.054(1) of the Texas Civil Practices & Remedies Code;

It is FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Stephen Matthew Avdeef is declared a

vexatious litigant pursuant to Section 11.054(2) of the Texas Civil Practices & Remedies Code;


It is FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Stephen Matthew Avdeef must provide security by obtaining a bond in the amount of \$579,486.00 no later than December 19, 2017 for the benefit of Defendants to assure payment of their reasonable expenses, including costs and attorney's fees, incurred in or in connection with this suit; DK

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Court will dismiss this litigation with prejudice if Plaintiff Stephen Matthew Avdeef does not provide the security within the designated time period;

It is FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Stephen Matthew Avdeef is prohibited from filing *pro se* any new litigation without first obtaining permission from the local administrative district judge of the county in which Plaintiff Stephen Matthew Avdeef intends to file; and

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is directed to notify the Office of Court Administration for the State of Texas of this Court's declaration of Stephen Matthew Avdeef as a vexatious litigant.
