## ORDER DELAYING EFFECTIVE DATE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE TEXAS DISCIPLINARY RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT AND THE TEXAS RULES OF DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE PENDING FURTHER ORDER OF THE COURT

**ORDERED** that:

1. On March 1, 2018, in Miscellaneous Docket Nos. 18-9030 and 18-9031, the Court gave preliminary approval to proposed amendments to Texas Disciplinary Rule of Professional Conduct 8.03 and to the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure. The amendments are required by the Act of May 28, 2017, 85th Leg., R.S., ch. 531 (SB 302). The orders made the rule amendments effective on June 1, 2018, after the expiration of a public-comment period.
2. The Court hereby delays the effective date of the rule amendments proposed in Misc. Docket Nos. 18-9030 and 18-9031 pending further order of the Court.


