**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT’S MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF A  
VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**

ON THIS DAY came on for consideration Defendant’s Motion to Declare Plaintiff, Michael D. Wilson, a Vexatious Litigant (“Motion”). After considering the Motion, any timely filed Response, and arguments of the Parties, if any, the Court:

GRANTS the Motion, declares Plaintiff Michael D. Wilson a vexatious litigant, and orders as follows:

1. Plaintiff must furnish security for the benefit of Defendant Threshold Paradise, L.P. d/b/a Station 3700 Apartment Homes, by posting a surety bond with the court clerk in the amount of \$ 4,000.00 by the 6<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2018. The security is to assure payment to the Defendant for reasonable expenses, including its court costs and attorney fees, should the case be dismissed on the merits.
2. If Plaintiff does not furnish security within the time limit set by this order, the Court will dismiss this suit with prejudice against Plaintiff.
3. Plaintiff must not file as a pro se party any new litigation in a court in Texas against any party without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge as required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies code section

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11.102(a).

4. As required by Texas civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.104, the court clerk will provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
