## ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF A <u>VEXATIOUS LITIGANT</u>

ON THIS DAY came on for consideration Defendant's Motion to Declare Plaintiff, Michael D. Wilson, a Vexatious Litigant ("Motion"). After considering the Motion, any timely filed Response, and arguments of the Parties, if any, the Court:

GRANTS the Motion, declares Plaintiff Michael D. Wilson a vexatious litigant, and orders as follows:

- 1. Plaintiff must furnish security for the benefit of Defendant Threshold Paradise,

  L.P. d/b/a Station 3700 Apartment Homes, by posting a surety bond with the court clerk in the amount of \$\frac{4}{1000.00}\$ by the day of \frac{2018}{2018}\$. The security is to assure payment to the Defendant for reasonable expenses, including its court costs and attorney fees, should the case be dismissed on the merits.
- 2. If Plaintiff does not furnish security within the time limit set by this order, the Court will dismiss this suit with prejudice against Plaintiff.
- 3. Plaintiff must not file as a pro se party any new litigation in a court in Texas against any party without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge as required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies code section

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11.102(a).

4. As required by Texas civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.104, the court clerk will provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
