Order Declaring James Laray Rowe a Vexatious Litigant

---

On February 13, 2019, the Court conducted a hearing to determine whether Petitioner James Laray Rowe should be declared a vexatious litigant, pursuant to Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.051, *et seq.* The hearing was held on the Defendant's motion. The Defendant appeared represented by counsel and Petitioner appeared in person and *pro se*. A record was made.

After considering the pleadings, the motion, the response, and the evidence and argument presented, the Court finds that the statutory elements are satisfied in all respects and therefore makes the following ORDER.

The Motion to Declare James Laray Rowe a Vexatious Litigant is GRANTED and the Court declares James Laray Rowe a vexatious litigant.

Petitioner James Laray Rowe is required to post bond in the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_ with the District Clerk as security per Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.055 within \_\_\_\_\_ days of this Order. If such security is not timely posted, this case will be dismissed with prejudice per Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.056.

Furthermore, the Court prohibits Petitioner James Laray Rowe from filing any new lawsuits *pro se* in any court in the State of Texas unless Petitioner receives permission from the appropriate local administrative judge pursuant to sections 11.101 and 11.102, Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code. Failure to comply with this Order may be punished by contempt and this Order is subject to all other lawful means of enforcement.

It is further ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court circulate this Order to its appropriate personnel and to forthwith, and no later than 30 days from the date hereof, provide a copy of this Order to the Office of Court Administration.
