Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Wednesday, May 29, 2019, beginning at 2:00 p.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Sandee Bryan Marion, Justice Patricia O. Alvarez, and Justice Irene Rios.

The following case will be presented:

In re Farmers Texas County Mutual Insurance Company- The real party in interest, Cassandra Longoria, sued her insurance company, Farmers Texas County Mutual Insurance (“relator”), for negligent failure to settle. Relator filed a Rule 91a motion to dismiss, which the trial court denied. Longoria later amended her petition to allege a cause of action for breach of contract. Relator filed a second Rule 91a motion to dismiss, which the trial court denied. In this original proceeding, relator asserts the trial court abused its discretion by denying both motions.

The oral arguments will be held in the Fourth Court’s Courtroom, Cadena-Reeves Justice Center, Third Floor, 300 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas.
