## ORDER ON RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DECLARE PETITIONER A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT

After considering Respondents', AYLENE SHAIKH, YASSER SHAIKH, JUNAID SHAIKH, and NICOLA SHAIKH, *Motion to Declare Petitioner, ZIA SHAIKH, a Vexatious Litigant*, Petitioner's response (if any), the evidence presented at the hearing, and the arguments of counsel, the Court:

**GRANTS** the motion, declares Petitioner a vexatious litigant, and orders as follows:

- 1. Petitioner must furnish security for the benefit of Respondents, AYLENE SHAIKH, YASSER SHAIKH, JUNAID SHAIKH, and NICOLA SHAIKH, by posting a surety bond with the court clerk in the amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) by December 16, 2019. The security is to assure payment to the Respondents for reasonable expenses, including their court costs and attorney fees, should the case be resolved adversely to Petitioner.
- 2. If Petitioner does not furnish security within the time limit set by this order, the Court will dismiss this suit with prejudice against Petitioner.
- 3. This suit will remain in abatement until Petitioner complies with this order or until it is dismissed by further order of this Court.
- 4. Petitioner must not file as a *pro se* party any new litigation in a court in Texas against any party without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge as required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.102(a).
- 5. As required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.104, the court clerk will provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
