Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral argument in an appeal on March 4, 2021, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Rebeca C. Martinez, Justice Irene Rios, and Justice Beth Watkins.

The following case will be presented:

City of San Antonio and Erik Walsh v. San Antonio Park Police Officers Association, Henry Bassuk, and Rogelio Tamez - This interlocutory appeal arises out of a trial court order denying a plea to the jurisdiction. On appeal, appellants City of San Antonio and Erik Walsh primarily assert that governmental immunity bars the suit and that appellees San Antonio Park Police Officers Association, Henry Bassuk, and Rogelio Tamez do not have standing.

In accordance with the Texas Supreme Court's emergency orders in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the oral argument will be held through the Fourth Court of Appeals' Zoom license.
