**ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY JOSEPH A. UNIS, JR.'S MOTION TO DECLARE MS. TISHA HENDERSON A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT, DISMISS FRIVOLOUS LAWSUIT WITH PREJUDICE, AND PROHIBIT FILING OF NEW LITIGATION**

ON THIS DAY, the Court considered Defendant Joseph A. Unis, Jr. ("Attorney Unis")'s Motion to Declare Ms. Tisha Henderson a Vexatious Litigant, Dismiss Frivolous Lawsuit with Prejudice, and Prohibit Filing of New Litigation ("Motion").


Having considered the Motion, any supplements, responses or replies thereto, the arguments of the parties, if any, Attorney Unis's March 9, 2021 letter to the Court, Tisha Henderson ("Ms. Henderson")'s Original Petition, Ms. Henderson's Affidavit of Inability to Pay, all lawsuits filed pro se by Ms. Henderson and determined adversely to her in the seven-year period immediately preceding the date of the Motion, Ms. Henderson's Grievance Form filed with the State Bar of Texas, and all other things properly before the Court, the Court **GRANTS** the Motion, **DECLARES** Ms. Henderson a vexatious litigant, and **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Ms. Henderson's claims against Attorney Unis are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.

2. Ms. Henderson shall not file as a pro se party any new litigation in a court in Texas against any party without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge, as required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code § 11.102(a).

3. As required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code § 11.104, the court clerk will provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
