Pursuant to Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 56.3, the Court severs the portion of the proceedings against Respondent Endeavor Energy Resources L.P. from case no. 23-0037 into case no. 23-0680, styled *Occidental Permian, Ltd., Occidental Petroleum Corporation, Oxy USA, Oxy USA WTP LP, and Rodeo Midland Basin, LLC v. Endeavor Energy Resources L.P.* Without considering the merits, the Court grants the petition for review in case no. 23-0680, vacates the court of appeals' judgment as to the claims severed into that

case, and remands that case to the trial court for rendition of a judgment in accordance with the parties' agreement. The remainder of the appeal in case no. 23-0037, restyled *Occidental Permian, Ltd., Occidental Petroleum Corporation, Oxy USA, Oxy USA WTP LP, and Rodeo Midland Basin, LLC v. Citation 2002 Investment LLC* remains pending before this Court.
