ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT TEXAS WORKFORCE COMMISSION'S MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that Plaintiff Alan Headman must post security for the benefit of Defendant Texas Workforce Commission in the amount of \$5,000.000 within 30 days of this Order;

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that the current proceedings are hereby stayed until Plaintiff Alan Headman posts the required security;

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that Plaintiff Alan Headman is

hereby prohibited from filing any new litigation in Upshur County, Texas as a *pro se* party without first obtaining the approval of a local administrative judge.
