On the 15th day of July, 2024 this cause was called for trial by jury and the parties appeared. The State appeared by her District Attorney as named above.
Counsel/Waiver of Counsel (select one) ☐ Defendant appeared with counsel. ☐ Defendant appeared without counsel and knowingly, intelligently, and voluntarily waived the right to representation by counsel in writing in open court. ☐ Defendant was tried in absentia.
Both parties announced ready for trial. It appeared to the Court that Defendant was mentally competent to stand trial. A jury was selected, impaneled, and sworn, and Defendant entered a plea to the charged offense. The Court received the plea and entered it of record. The jury heard the evidence submitted and argument of counsel. The Court charged the jury as to its duty to determine the guilt or innocence of Defendant, and the jury retired to consider the evidence. Upon returning to open court, the jury delivered its verdict in the presence of Defendant and defense counsel, if any. On the 19th day of July, 2024 the Court again called this cause and received the verdict and Ordered it entered upon the minutes of the Court.
Punishment Assessed by Jury / Court / No election (select one) Jury. Defendant entered a plea and filed a written election to have the jury assess punishment. The jury heard evidence relative to the question of punishment. The Court charged the jury and it retired to consider the question of punishment. After due deliberation, the jury was brought into Court, and, in open court, it returned its verdict as indicated above. Court. Defendant elected to have the Court assess punishment. After hearing evidence relative to the question of punishment, the Court assessed Defendant's punishment as indicated above. No Election. Defendant did not file a written election as to whether the judge or jury should assess punishment. After hearing evidence relative to the question of punishment, the Court assessed Defendant's punishment as indicated above. In accordance with the jury's verdict, the Court ADJUDGES Defendant Guilly of the above offense. The Court FINDS that the Presentence Investigation, if so ordered, was done according to the applicable provisions of Subchapter F, Chapter 42A, Tex. Code Crim. Proc. The Court Orders Defendant punished in accordance with the jury's verdict or Court's findings as to the proper punishment as indicated above. After having conducted an inquiry into Defendant's ability to pay, the Court Orders Defendant to pay the fines, court costs, reimbursement fees, and restitution as indicated above and further detailed below.

Defendant shall be confined in the county jail for the period indicated above. Upon release from confinement, the Court Orders Defendant to proceed without unnecessary delay to the District Clerk's office, or any other office designated by the Court or the Court's designee, to pay or to make arrangements to pay any fines, court costs, reimbursement fees, and restitution due.
