

## Judicial Internships

The Texas Court of Criminal Appeals is the State's highest court for criminal cases. The Court accepts applications for judicial internships for the fall school semester, the spring school semester, and the summer. Interns primarily conduct research and prepare memoranda to assist the Court in making decisions. An intern's work is supervised by the judge's staff attorney and law clerk.
