The Sixth Court of Appeals is accepting resumes from law students who will be rising second- and third-year students during the summer of 2025 for unpaid judicial internship positions.

The Sixth Court's intern program provides an opportunity to improve research and writing skills, while also providing a behind-the-scenes view of how an intermediate court of appeals works. Interns research factual and legal issues and will write legal memoranda. Interns will work with the Court's attorneys in this endeavor. Interns, when possible, may have the opportunity to attend a trial with a Court attorney, and, when possible, may have an opportunity to visit the Eastern District of Texas and the Western District of Arkansas Federal Courts. If the Court has scheduled oral argument during the period of internship, the intern will observe oral argument and will observe post-submission resolution of legal issues raised in oral argument.

Affordable housing options are available on the Texas A&M University Campus in Texarkana. On campus housing includes a dormitory room, utilities, and access to laundry rooms and kitchen. Rates are typically less than \$30.00 per night during the summer.
