**ORDER FINDING NOEL LIFE IS A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT AS DEFINED BY  
CHAPTER 11 OF THE TEXAS CIVIL PRACTICE AND REMEDIES CODE**

On this day, the **20th** of **March 2025**, came to be considered Edward Zuniga’s Motion for Order Determining Plaintiff Noel Life is a Vexatious Litigant.

After considering the motion, the pleadings, the evidence, and arguments presented by both parties, the Court is of the opinion that Edward Zuniga’s Motion should be **GRANTED** and is in all things **GRANTED**.

**It is therefore ORDERED** that plaintiff is deemed a vexatious litigant as defined by Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

**It is further ORDERED** as to plaintiff Noel Life’s lawsuit against Mr. Zuniga herein, that Noel Life be required to post a security bond of **\$7,500.00** to the El Paso County Texas District Clerk within 45 days after rendition of this Order. If Noel Life does not furnish said security by **May 5, 2025**, it is **ORDERED** that all of Noel Life’s claims brought against Mr. Zuniga in the instant suit, or that could have been brought against Mr. Zuniga, shall be **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.

**It is further ORDERED** that Noel Life is prohibited from filing, pro se, a new litigation in EL PASO COUNTY without permission of the appropriate local administrative judge as described by Section 11.102(a).

**THEREFORE, it is ORDERED** that the clerk of the EL PASO COUNTY may not file a litigation, original proceeding, appeal, or other claim presented, pro se, by Noel Life subject to a prefiling order unless Noel Life obtains an order from the appropriate local administrative judge which is Judge Stephen Ables of the Sixth Administrative Judicial Region as of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of this court shall provide the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System a copy of this order not later than the 30th day after the date this order is signed.
